WE, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we are the duly elected Board of Trustees of CALDWELL AERIE #3691 FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES, a fraternal organization, duly authorized and directed to form this corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho.

I.

The corporate name of this corporation shall be "CALDWELL AERIE #3691 FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES, INC."

II.

The purposes and objects for which said corporation is formed are:

- a. To establish in the City of Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho, a subordinate Aerie of the Grand Aerie, Fraternal Order of Eagles, for charitable, benevolent and fraternal purposes, according to the constitution, laws, rules and regulations of the Grand Aerie, Fraternal Order of Eagles.
- b. To take charge of such buildings, estate and property as this Aerie may lawfully acquire.
- c. To acquire and hold title in fee simple, in trust, or otherwise, to both real and personal property, and to improve, encumber, sell, convey and dispose of all such property.
- d. To exercise any and all powers of a charitable, benevolent and fraternal corporation as provided by Idaho Law.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be Caldwell, Canyon County, Idaho.

At the meeting a majority of the organization were present and voted and the undersigned were unanimously elected the Board of Trustees for the organization and were duly authorized and directed to proceed with the incorporation of said organization.




