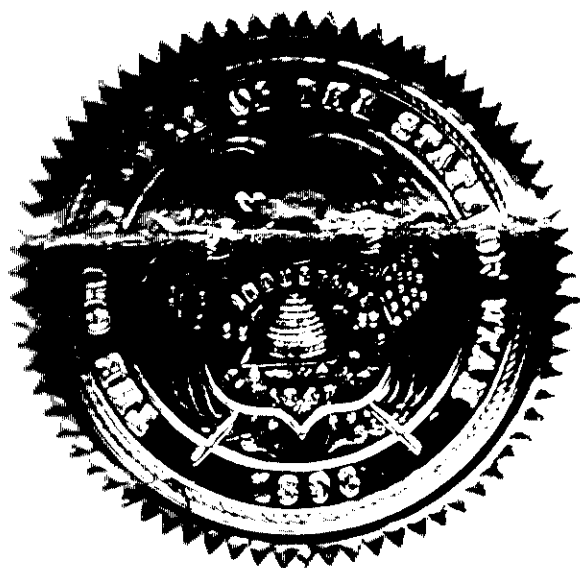

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
TO THE  
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
KEARNS-TRIBUNE CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Business Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is KEARNS-TRIBUNE CORPORATION.

SECOND: The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the shareholders of the corporation on September 28, 1970, in the manner prescribed by the Utah Business Corporation Act:

Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation of the corporation is amended to read:

CAPITAL STOCK. The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 500,000 shares without par value.

THIRD: The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 404,626; and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 404,626.

FOURTH: The designation and number of outstanding shares of each class entitled to vote thereon as a class were as follows:

FIFTH: The number of shares voted for such amendment was 404,626; and the number of shares voted against

such amendment was zero.

SIXTH: The number of shares of each class entitled to vote thereon as a class voted for and against such amendment, respectively, was:

SEVENTH: The manner, if not set forth in such amendment, in which any exchange, reclassification, or cancellation of issued shares provided for in the amendment shall be effected, is as follows: Each of the 404,626 shares of \$10.00 par value common stock presently outstanding is changed to one share of common stock without par value.

EIGHTH: The manner in which such amendment effects a change in the amount of stated capital, and the amount of stated capital as changed by such amendment are as follows: The board of directors has adopted, effective on the filing of these Articles of Amendment, a resolution fixing a stated value of \$1.00 for each outstanding share of common stock of the corporation. This amendment and the foregoing resolution of the board of directors, thus served to reduce the stated capital of the corporation from \$4,046,260 to \$404,626.
