

Certificate of Incorporation
of
The Idaho, Utah and Oregon Railway Co.

Know all men by these Presents, That we the undersigned have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the Territory of Idaho, a Corporation to be known by the corporate name of "The Idaho, Utah and Oregon Railway Co."

And we hereby certify that the objects for which this Corporation is formed, are:

The construction and operating of Railroad and Telegraph lines in the Territories of Idaho and Utah, and in the State of Oregon and adjoining States and Territories, namely: From Boise City in Ada County, Idaho Territory, in a west and westerly direction, to or near a point on Burnt River known as Durbin Ranch in Baker County, State of Oregon, with a branch road from some point in Ada County to or near Horse Shoe Bend on the Payette river in Boise County, Idaho Territory, and from the said Boise City, in an easterly direction to Atlanta in Blaine County in the Territory of Idaho, with a branch line to Idaho City in Boise County, Territory of Idaho, and from the said Boise City, in a southeasterly direction to Ogden in Weber County, Territory of Utah, said lines to be located on such routes as we may hereafter select.

That the Capital Stock of this Corporation shall be Five Million \$5,000,000 Dollars divided into Fifty thousand 50,000 Shares of the par value of

One Hundred \$100⁰⁰ Dollars each.

That the time of its existence shall be fifty years from and after the date of this Certificate.

That the number of its Trustees shall be nine (9) and that the names of those who shall be trustees and manage its affairs during the first three months and until their successors are elected, are;

John Lemup, H. B. Eastman, L. W. Moore, A. H. Boomer, J. B. Broadbent, F. R. Coffin, S. Falk, R. Z. Johnson and John Hailey.

That its principal place of business shall be in Boise City, Ada County, Idaho Territory.
