

## **ATTACHMENT**

**The partnership shall dissolve only upon the occurrence of one or more of the following:**

1. The bankruptcy, withdrawal, or dissolution of <sup>Boise</sup> Eastgate, Inc.;
2. Written agreement of all partners; or,
3. Complete cessation of all business activities and full payment of all outstanding indebtedness secured by real property owned by the partnership.

**In the event of the death, disability, withdrawal, bankruptcy, or other act of any partner that would ordinarily result in dissolution, other than as set forth above, the acting partner or his successor in interest, shall be considered, for all purposes, as an assignee of the acting partner, the acting partner shall no longer have any rights to participate in management of the partnership, and the partnership shall not dissolve but shall continue until dissolution as set forth above.**
