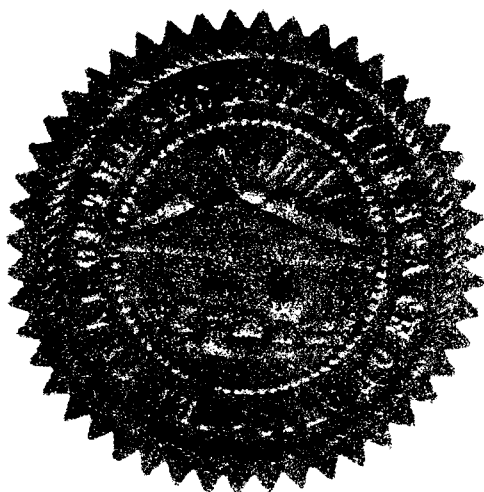

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE OHIO MATCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under the General Corporation Law of Ohio, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of said Corporation shall be THE OHIO MATCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION.

ARTICLE II

The place in this State where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is Wadsworth, Medina County.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which and for any of which said Corporation is formed are:

- (1) To receive contributions or gifts from The Ohio Match Company and any subsidiary corporation, and others.
- (2) To make contributions or gifts to a corporation, trust, or community chest, fund or foundation, created or organized in the United States or in any possession thereof or under the law of the United States, or of any State or Territory, or of the

District of Columbia, or of any possession of the United States, organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, Vol. 687
scientific, literary, or educational purposes or for the preven- page 66
tion of cruelty to children or animals (but in the case of contri-
butions to a trust, chest, fund, or foundation, only if such
contributions or gifts are to be used within the United States or
any of its possessions exclusively for such purposes), no part
of the net earnings of which inures to the benefit of any private
shareholder or individual, and no substantial part of the activities
of which is carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to
influence legislation, provided, however, that no part of such
contributions or gifts shall be devoted in any way to any other
than charitable, scientific, hospital, or educational purposes
conducive to the public welfare.

(3) Subject to the conditions and limitations in (2) above, to
do all things and exercise all rights and powers permitted to
corporations not for profit created under the laws of the State
of Ohio, including but without limiting the generality of the fore-
going, the right to acquire, hold, use, control and dispose of
any kind or kinds of property, and to do any and all things incidental
thereto.

ARTICLE IV

The names and addresses of the three persons who are to act as Trustees of the corporation until the selection of their successors and who are to be members of the corporation are as follows:

The number of persons so named shall constitute the number of Trustees of the corporation until changed by amendment to these Articles of Incorporation, or by amendment to Code of Regulations of the Corporation. Authority is hereby given for the adoption of a provision in the Code of Regulations of the corporation concerning the number of Trustees of the corporation and for any changes therein.

ARTICLE V

The existence of the corporation shall commence with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation in accordance with law and shall thereafter be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

If this corporation is dissolved at any time and for any reason, the net residue of assets remaining shall not be distributed to the members hereof, but shall be distributed to such persons, corporations, or other organizations who are entitled to receive aid, assistance and support from this corporation during its existence in accordance with the purposes hereinbefore set forth, in such amounts and proportions as the Trustees shall determine.
