CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, JAS H. YOUNG, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

ASSEMBLY OF GOD OF SWEET, IDAHO, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the 12th day of August A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-eight and is duly recorded on Film No. 103 of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at Sweet in the County of Gem and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ASSEMBLY OF GOD OF SWEET, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons, of full age and citizens of the United States, and associated together as members of a church organization, of which pecuniary profit is not an object, in accordance with the rules, regulations and discipline of such organization, and for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, do now, on this 8th day of August, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-eight, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves, and do hereby make and execute the following Articles of Incorporation, and do hereby certify as follows, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be "ASSEMBLY OF GOD OF SWEET, IDAHO, INC."

ARTICLE II

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation, and the place where the principal business of the corporation is to be transacted is Sweet, Gem County, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes for which this corporation is formed and is to be conducted and operated are as follows:

1. To operate and maintain an Assembly of God Church in the town of Sweet, Idaho; to promote religious worship; to teach and preach the Word of God; to establish and maintain a place of

worship and teachings for the meetings of the church; to carry on and conduct missionary, educational and charitable work.

2. To purchase, have, hold, lease, use and take possession of, and enjoy in fee simple, or otherwise, any real or personal property necessary or incident to, or in connection with the purposes of the corporation, and to sell, lease, alien, mortgage or otherwise hypothecate such property; to borrow money for the accomplishment of any of the above enumerated purposes.

3. The above enumerated purposes shall also be considered as a statement of powers, and this corporation may do each and every thing suitable or proper for the accomplishment or attainment of any one or more thereof or conducive to or expedient for the interest or benefit of the corporation; in addition thereto the corporation shall have, and may exercise any other of further rights, powers and privileges granted by law to corporations of a religious character.

ARTICLE V

Pecuniary profit is not the object of this corporation, and it shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VI

The terms of admission and qualifications for membership in this corporation are provided for in the bylaws which have been adopted.

ARTICLE VII

The government of this corporation and the management of its affairs shall be vested in a board of three directors, to be elected by the members at the annual meeting of the corporation, as provided in the bylaws. No person shall be the director of this corporation unless he be a member of the corporation, and a regular contributor to the support of the church. Such Board shall select from their own number a President, Vice-president and Secretary-Treasurer.

ARTICLE VIII

In the event a division shall occur within this corporation, the personal and real property of this corporation shall belong to that portion thereof which adheres to the doctrines and precepts of the General Council of the Assemblies of God with National Headquarters at Springfield, Missouri.

ARTICLE IX

That a duly called meeting of the members of this corporation was held at the church building of the Assembly of God Church, in Sweet, Gem County, Idaho, which said church building is the place where said members regularly meet for public worship and transaction of business, on Friday, the 8th day of August, 1958, at the hour of eight o'clock P. M., at which meeting a majority of the members who were present voted for the election of directors; that due and regular notice of the time and place of holding such meeting and election was given by publication thereof for at least two weeks in the Emmett Messenger Index, a weekly newspaper published and of general circulation in Gem County, Idaho, the County where said election was held, and was published in every issue thereof, commencing with the 24th day of July, 1958 and ending with the 7th day of August, 1958; and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held, on the 24th day of July, 1958, which remained so posted at all times from posting until the time of said election, said notice being posted on the front door of said church building.

That at said meeting, the following persons were duly elected directors of this corporation by unanimous vote of said members:

ARTICLE X

That the names of all of the incorporators of this corporation are as listed for directors in Article IX hereof, and that the post office address of each of said incorporators is Sweet, Idaho.

ARTICLE XI

That at said meeting, these Articles of Incorporation were by unanimous vote duly adopted and said persons so elected as Directors were duly authorized and directed to execute and file the same for record, and to duly incorporate this association for and on behalf of its members.

ARTICLE XII

Bylaws containing provisions governing membership, membership fees, terms of officers and directors, creation of such committees and boards as may be desirable, meetings of the corporation, and all matters properly in the purview of bylaws have been prepared and submitted to the Association and have been duly adopted by the Association.
