I, JAS H. YOUNG, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

WHITNEY FRIENDS CHURCH OF BOISE, Incorporated

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **twenty-sixth** day of **June,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-Nine,** and is duly recorded on Film No. **107** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise,** in the County of **Ada,** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
THIRTY FRIENDS CHURCH OF BOISE, INCORPORATED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, whose names are subscribed hereto, all of whom are natural persons of full age, and citizens of the United States, and actual bona fide residents of the state of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together to form a non-profit corporation to establish and maintain a Friends Church, and in order to form such corporation under and pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho statutes, Chapter II, Title 30-1101 and 30-1102 Idaho Code, do hereby certify and declare as follows:

I

That the name of this corporation is and shall be

THIRTY FRIENDS CHURCH OF BOISE, Incorporated

II

PURPOSE OF THE CORPORATION

That the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are, without pecuniary profit, to establish and maintain a Friends Church according to the Discipline of Oregon Yearly Meeting of Friends Church.

For the accomplishment of these purposes and objects the corporation shall have power to publish and distribute such literature as will carry out the objects of the corporation; to lease suitable buildings and equipment, and to acquire by purchase or gift such personal and real property as may be necessary to carry out the objects of this corporation, and to execute such trusts; to mortgage or otherwise encumber any of its property, or to sell and convey the same.

To do any and all things necessary or useful or customarily incident to the carrying on of a religious institution; and in furtherance and not in limitation of powers herein mentioned and those conferred by the laws of Idaho, the corporation shall also have the power to borrow money in the name of the corporation, and to make, execute, issue, deliver, sell and otherwise dispose of promissory notes, bonds or other obligations for money borrowed, or in payment of property acquired, or for any other purpose of the corporation.

III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

IV

This institution is located on lots 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of Block 27 of Eagleson Park Addition in Ada County, Idaho.

V

The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted by a board of not less than five (5) nor more than thirty-five (35) trustees, the number in excess of five to be fixed from time to time by the members of the Whitney Friends Church of Boise, Incorporated in business session as provided in the Discipline of Oregon Yearly Meeting of Friends Church. These trustees shall be subject to all restrictions, policies and classes as designated by said Discipline of Oregon Yearly Meeting of Friends Church.

VI

The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit, and it shall not have nor issue any capital stock. Membership on the board shall not entitle a person to any interest whatsoever in the assets of the corporation, but only to participate in the management of the affairs of the corporation in meetings legally called and held within the period covered by the membership.

VII

The persons associated with the corporation shall not be assessed nor required to pay for the debts, operating expenses, or other obligations of the corporation.

VIII

The notice of the holding of an election for five directors who shall be called trustees of this corporation was given by causing to be posted at the entrance to the auditorium in which the election was held and published for two consecutively weekly insertions in the Tuesday editions of the Idaho Daily Statesman, the following notice, to wit:
