**Article II: The corporation is a nonprofit corporation. The purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.**

**Article VIII: Upon dissolution of the organization, the assets shall be distributed to one or more organizations exempt within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding sections of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas, of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusive for such purposes.**

**Article IX: Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.**
