

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION?

OF

ANDERSON BROS. BANK.

This agreement made and concluded this 22nd. day of March 1898, by and between Robert Anderson, John G. Anderson, Alice J. Anderson , Benjamin Gratz and Anderson Gratz.

Witnesseth ; that the foregoing and undersigned parties, a majority of whom are bonifide residents freeholders of the state of Idaho, are desirous of forming a corporation for the purpose of carrying on a general Banking business, buying and selling Real Estate and personal property as herein after more fully set forth.

Now therefore the said named and undersigned parties do hereby certify, declare and agree, as hereinafter set forth, and do hereby for the purposes aforesaid and hereinafter mentioned, associate themselves together as a body corporate, and hereby adopt and enter into the following agreement under the laws of the State of Idaho, to wit :

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

FIRST.

The name of this corporation is and shall be " Anderson Bros. Bank. "

Second,

This Corporation shall continue in existance for the period of Fifty years unless sooner dissolved and disincorporated according to law.

THIRD.

The business and persuits of this corporation shall be the conducting of a general Banking business, trading or otherwise disposing of, such personal property and real estate as may be deemed necessary for the proper and profitable carrying on of such business.

FOURTH.

The place where the principal business of this Corporation is to be transacted shall be Idaho Falls, County of Bingham, State of Idaho.

FIFTH.

The amount of the capital stock of this Corporation shall be Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars, which shall be divided into five hundred shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars each.

SIXTH.

The officers of this Corporation shall consist of a Board of five Directors, a President, Secretary and a Cashier, whose qualifications shall be to hold and own stock in this Corporation, and whose term of office shall be one year and until their successors shall be elected and qualified.

The President, ^{Secretary} and Cashier shall be elected by the Board of Directors and may be members of the Board of Directors.

SEVENTH.

There shall be held an annual meeting of the stock holders of this Corporation on the Second Tuesday in January at 10 o'clock A. M. in each and every year in the Bank in Idaho Falls, Idaho, for the election of Directors and the transaction of such other business as shall lawfully come before it. Special meetings of the stockholders shall be called and held as provided by the by laws to be adopted as hereinafter provided.

EIGHTH.

The stockholders of this Corporation may from time to time at any regular or special meetings adopt such by laws not inconsistent with these articles as may be necessary for the proper conducting and management of the business of this Corporation.

NINTH.

Any officer of this Corporation may resign by delivering his written resignation to the Board of Directors, and any vacancies which may occur by reason of the death, resignation or removal of any officer shall be filled until the next annual meeting, by the Board of Directors.

Any officer or agent elected or appointed by the Board of Directors may be removed by a vote of a majority of said Board of Directors.

TENTH.

The following named persons shall be the officers of this Corporation and its Board of Directors until the regular election to be held at the first annual meeting as hereinbefore provided, and until the officers and Directors then elected are duly qualified, to wit:

John C. Anderson,	President and Director.
Robert Anderson,	Cashier and Director and Secretary
Alice J. Anderson,	Director.
Benjamin Gratz,	Director.
Anderson Gratz,	Director.

But any of the said officers or directors may resign or be removed as hereinbefore provided.

ELEVENTH.

The individual or private property of the stockholders of this Corporation shall not be liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of this Corporation.

TWELFTH.

These articles may be altered, amended or changed in any particular not inconsistent with the laws of Idaho, at any meeting of the stockholders called and held for that purpose, providing that two thirds of the capital stock of the Corporation votes for the same.

THIRTEENTH.

The names, places of residence, number of shares and the amount of capital of stock of each of the subscribers hereto by them respectively subscribed as follows:

FOURTEENTH.

All of the notes , Bills receivable, Bonds, Book accounts, Cash and other personal property now belongingto the private bank of Anderson Bros. in Idaho Falls, Idaho, as shown by the books of said Anderson Bros. Bank; being all of such personal property as is now owned jointly by Robert Anderson and John C. Anderson in said private bank. Also : all of the Real Estate now owned jointly by Robert Anderson and John C. Anderson, whether in Bingham County, Idaho, or elsewhere, as is more fully shown by deeds to this Corporation, and on record in Bingham County, Idaho, and else where.

The said real estate is to be received by this Corporation at the valuation of Ten Thousand dollars \$10,000 : and the personal property is to be received at the valuation of Forty Thousand \$40,000 Dollars.

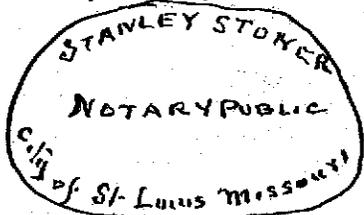

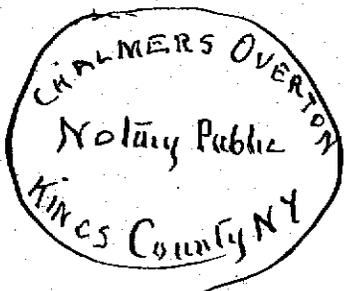

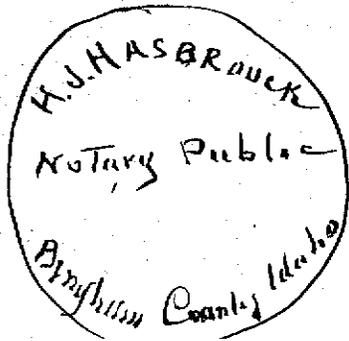
