I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

ST. PAUL MEMORIAL CHURCH, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Eighth** day of **August**, A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **124** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Coeur d'Alene** in the County of **Kootenai** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ST. PAUL MEMORIAL CHURCH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are full aged citizens of the United States, and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of this corporation shall be: St. Paul Memorial Church, Inc.

II.

That the principal place of business shall be at Coeur D'Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho.

III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV.

The annual meeting of this corporation for hearing reports, election of officers, and such other business, shall be held on or about the last Wednesday in January of each year.

V.

Pecuniary profit is not the object of this corporation, but said corporation is organized for the purpose of promoting the cause of the Christian religion; to promulgate the doctrines and teachings of St. Paul Memorial Church; to provide for its members a place of worship to be conducted in accordance with the rules and by-laws of the St. Paul Memorial Church; to receive, hold, and disburse gifts, bequests, devises and other funds for said purposes; to own and maintain suitable real estate and buildings for its purposes and to do all things necessary and incident thereto.

VI.

That an election of officers has been held at the Fort Sherman Chapel, Woodland and Hubbard Streets, July 25, 1963; that a majority of the members were present and voted; that a board of trustees consisting of four members was elected to be responsible for the management of all real estate and buildings; that a board of elders of six members was elected and vested with the responsibility of the spiritual affairs, government and discipline of the church; that notice of said election was published two weeks in advance in the local newspaper and that notice of same was posted at the place of election for the same length of time; that the result of that election was:
