ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE EH-CAPA BAREBACK RIDERS OF BOISE, INCORPORATED

We, the Undersigned, Being desirous of forming a Social Corporation as provided by Title 30, Chapter 10 of the Idaho Code and under the authority of the Corporate Laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify and declare as our Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of this Corporation shall be the "Eh-Capa Bareback Riders of Boise, Idaho" and a corporate seal as set out and attached hereto is hereby adopted.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

This Corporation is formed as a social association not for profit, and no director, active member or supervising member shall receive any salary or other compensation by virtue of membership nor be entitled to any profit or pecuniary gain thereby, the objects and purposes of this association being:

- (a) To form a voluntary non-profit association of adults to encourage and supervise membership in a children's riding club, limited to minors underthe age of twenty-one (21) years, residents of the Boise Valley, Idaho area;
- (b) To permit, subject to the supervision and control, the management and conduct of such riding club by the active mambers thereof;
- (c) To encourage thereby, the young people of the Boise Valley Area, through this association, to take an active part and participate in all equestrian activities and to develope skill and interest as horsemen and horsewomen and;
- (d) To instill in the young people of this area an understanding, appreciation and ability to discharge the responsibilities of caring for the Horse.

and in this regard this association shall be authorized to accept all gifts; to purchase, sell or otherwise deal in any property of any kind or character; to negotiate and enter into contracts or other agreements to the same extent as any private individual might do and as might be necessary, desirable, or expedient in carrying out the foregoing purposes; to maintain accounts of deposit or otherwise at any bank or financial institution, it being hereby expressly provided that the enumeration herein above of the specific objects and powers of this association shall not be narrowly construed and shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner, the powers of this association.

ARTICLE III

Incorporators

all of whom are over twenty-one (21) years of age and shall serve as supervising directors and officers of this association.

ARTICLE IV

Membership

Membership in this association shall be non-assignable and the interests of all members shall be equal and of two classes, each having rights and responsibilities as herein set out or defined.

Section 1. Supervising Members.

Supervising membership shall be limited to adult persons, residents of the Boise Valley area interested in the promotion of horsemanship and the objectives of this association. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member may have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

Section 2. Active Members.

Active membership shall be limited to minors under the age of twenty-one (21) years who are active participants in the affairs of this association.

Section 3. Membership.

Membership in this association shall consist of supervising and active members. Membership shall be on a family basis, and shall be complete upon nomination and payment of dues in the amount of ten (\$10.00) dollars and such other assessment as set by the Board of Directors, but not to exceed ten (\$10.00) dollars per family.

ARTICLE V

Directors and Officers

There shall be ten (10) directors of this association, five of whom shall be supervising members, and five of whom shall be active members, and these directors shall be charged with the supervision of the affairs of this association as herein set out and defined.

Section 1. Supervising Directors. At each annual meeting hereafter, an election shall be held at which five (5) supervising members shall be elected by the supervising membership as supervising directors of this association to serve a one year term. Three (3) of the directors so elected shall additionally serve as officers of this association and be elected and designated as (a) President, (b) Vice-President, and (c) Secretary.

The supervising directors and officers shall conduct the promotion, operation and affairs of this association. The supervising directors shall be charged with the responsibility for the conduct of the legal affairs of the association, the adoption of such additional rules or by-laws as may be required or desirable and the supervision of the active members.

Section 2. Active Directors. At each annual meeting hereafter, an election shall be held at which active members shall be elected by the active membership as active directors of the association to serve a one year term.

The active directors so elected shall serve as officers of the "Active Membership" association and designated as (a) President, (b) Vice-President, (c) Secretary, (d) Treasurer, (e) Sergeant-at-Arms. They shall conduct the affairs and activities of this association, subject to the supervision of the supervising directors.

ARTICLE VI

Elections and Meetings

There shall be an annually-scheduled meeting of the members of this association each year, to be held in January, at which time an election of directors and officers for both the supervising and active membership shall be held.

ARTICLE VII

Corporate Status

This association shall have a perpetual existence and shall maintain an office and corporate address within Ada County, Idaho; the present office and address being:

Wayne Stear Rt. #3, Five Mile Road Boise, Idaho and the association shall at all times be governed by the general or corporate laws of the State of Idaho, the Articles or their amendments and such by-laws as may be hereinafter adopted. A quorum for the transaction of any general or special business of this association or the amendment of these articles shall be fifty percent of the supervising membership.

ARTICLE VIII

Amendmen ts

These articles may be amended at any time by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the supervising membership constituting a quorum and such other or additional associate directors or other officers from either the supervising or the active membership may be designated or appointed as may be desired.
