

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

GROVE CITY DITCH COMPANY, LIMITED.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the STATE of Idaho, and do hereby certify;

FIRST.

That the name of said corporation is The GROVE CITY DITCH COMPANY, (Limited,)

SECOND.

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is to maintain, and enlarge if necessary, that certain irrigating ditch beginning at and diverting water from the Corbett Slough Ditch Company's Canal, at a point in section ~~(2)~~ ³⁶ town-
ship ~~(2)~~ ^{Yur (2)} ~~(2)~~ ^{after terminus of said canal} south of range thirty-five (35) east, B.M. and running thence southwesterly to the village of Blackfoot, in the County of Bingham, and State of Idaho, together with all laterals now constructed and conveying water from main ditch to the town lots owned by the stockholders of this corporation, lying and being east of the OREGON SHORT LINE RAILWAY, in said town of Blackfoot, to buy, sell, and rent water, and to own and control such real estate as may be necessary for the purposes of said corporation

THIRD.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the town of Blackfoot, in Bingham County, State of Idaho.

FOURTH.

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after its incorporation.

FIFTH.

That the capital stock of said corporation shall be divided into ~~One~~ ^{Fifteen} HUNDRED ~~Twenty~~ SHARES of the par value of TEN DOLLARS each; said stock to be assessed as provided by law for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses incurred by said corporation in the conducting of its business only.

SIXTH.

That one share of the Corbett Slough stock shall represent five shares in this corporation, and one share in this corporation represents $(4/7)$ four sevenths of an inch of water.

That the stock subscribed in this corporation is fully paid up and non-assessable, and the same is and shall remain non-assessable (except for the purposes of paying the necessary expenses of the company in the conducting of its business) and said stock shall be neither subject to assessment or call, and the liability of the stockholders is and shall be limited as provided by the laws of the STATE OF IDAHO.
