Articles of Incorporation of H & C Farm Supply

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We, the undersigned, citizens of the United States and residents of the state of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves, and do hereby unite and associate ourselves together, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the state of Idaho, and we hereby certify:

I.

That the name of said corporation is H & C Farm Supply Corporation.

II.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To carry on, both as retailer and wholesaler, a general merchant and merchandise business, and to purchase, sell and deal in such goods, supplies or merchandise as are, or may be sold, in a general store.
- (b) To buy, sell, barter, exchange and deal generally, both as jobbers and manufacturers, in all classes of goods, wares and merchandise and articles of trade, including all kinds of chemicals and fertilizers, machinery, spray equipment, surface and air vehicles, clothing, groceries, seeds and nursery stock, boats, sporting equipment, electric appliances, soft drinks, pails, furniture, floor coverings, all kinds of interior decorating supplies, automotive supplies, poultry and livestock feeds and supplies, and veterinarian supplies.
- (c) To acquire and own real property, and to erect, construct, alter and repair buildings or other structures.
- (d) To manufacture, fabricate, assemble, purchase, or otherwise acquire; to own, hold, use and enjoy; to sell, assign and transfer, exchange or otherwise dispose of, and to invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares, and merchandise and supplies and all other personal property of every class and description.
- (e) To acquire, hold, use, sell, assign, lease, grant licenses

in respect of, or otherwise dispose of, letters patent of the United States or any foreign country, patent rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, improvements and processes, copyrights, trade-marks and trade names relating to, or useful in connection with, any business of this corporation.

(f) To own and in every way deal in stocks and bonds of other corporations.

(g) To mortgage, pledge or otherwise encumber any and all property of the corporation.

III.

That the principal and registered offices of this corporation shall be situated, and the principal business shall be transacted, in Idaho Falls, Idaho, which is also the post office address of its registered office; and said corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

IV.

That said corporation shall have three directors, one of whom shall be elected for one year, one for two years, and one for three years, and at each annual election the successor to the director whose term shall expire in that year, shall be elected to hold office for three years.

V.

The total authorized capital stock of the said corporation shall be \$50,000, divided into 50,000 shares of the par value of \$1 each. The amount of actual capital with which said corporation shall begin business is \$50,000.

VI.

Of the said shares of the said capital stock, there has actually been subscribed the sum of \$50,000 by the following named
