ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

STEGNER GRAIN & SEED, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, JOHN J. STEGNER, BARBARA J. STEGNER and THOMAS A. MADDEN, each of whom is a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho and we do hereby adabt the following articles of incorporation, viz:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be

STEGNER GRAIN & SEED, INC.

Article II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

To engage in and carry on a general warehousing and storage business, particularly including but not limited to the warehousing and storage of farm products.

To engage in and carry on a general mercantile business, both wholesale and retail, particularly including but not limited to soil fertilizers, crop sprays, animal feeds and medicines, sacks, twine and all types of farm chemicals and supplies and merchandise of every kind type and description.

To engage in and carry on the business of buying and selling, processing and marketing, as well as storing and handling all types of farm produce and farm products, particularly including but not limited to all types of seeds and grains.

To rent, lease, own and operate automobiles, trucks, tractors and motor vehicles of every kind and nature and to transport persons and property therein for hire and to let the same for hire.

To acquire and own stock, bonds and securities of other corporations, and while owning the same, to

exercise all the privileges of ownership consistent with the corporate character of this company.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, use, enjoy, lease, let, demise, sell and dispose of real property and any and all interests therein.

To make and perform contracts of every lawful kind with any person, firm, association or corporation.

To borrow money, to lend money, and to evidence the indebtedness of the company by notes, bonds or other instruments and to secure the same by pledge, mortgage, trust deed or such other instruments as the company may deem proper.

To acquire, own, enjoy, sell and dispose of patents and patent rights, trademarks, copyrights, and licenses and franchises of any and every kind whatsoever.

To do any and all things incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred upon corporations of like character, and without in any particular limiting any of the character, and without in any particular limiting any of the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation, the business and purposes of the company shall be, from time to time, to do any one or more or all of the acts and things herein set forth and all such other acts, things and business, in any manner connected with, therewith, or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary thereto, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or enhance the value of any of its property or rights as such corporation may lawfully do; and in carrying on its business or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law and either, as or by and through principals, agents, attorneys, trustees, contractors, factors, lessors, lessees or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with others.

Article III.

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

Article IV.

The number of directors of this corporation shall be three; but said number may be increased to five or more at any time as may be provided by

the By-Laws of said corporation from time to time.

Article V.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Grangeville, Idaho County, Idaho, and the mailing address and registered office of the corporation shall be Grangeville, Idaho.

Article VI.





