We, the undersigned, being natural persons of legal age, all citizens of the United States of America or its territories or possessions, and duly licensed, or otherwise legally authorized, to render the same professional services within the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a professional corporation pursuant to Idaho Code for the purpose of rendering veterinary services, and adopt the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be KINGHORN, KINGHORN, AND KINGHORN, A PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purpose for which the corporations is formed is to engage in the mixed practice of veterinary medicine.

In connection with the above mentioned purpose, the corporation shall have the power to invest its funds in real property and securities, to acquire, own, and dispose of real and personal property, and to do all other acts to the extent permitted under law.

ARTICLE THREE

PRINCIPAL OFFICE
