

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
GRANDVIEW CEMETERY ASSOCIATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, Lydia E. Shultis, W. T. James, Agnes C. Stamm, J. A. Jacoby and C. D. Simonds of Boundary County, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporative association under the laws of the State of Idaho;

And we hereby certify:

1.

That the name of said association is GRANDVIEW CEMETERY ASSOCIATION.

2.

That the purposes or objects for which the Grandview Cemetery Association is formed are to maintain a cemetery in Boundary County Idaho; to purchase, buy, lease and hold such real-estate, property, buildings and equipment as may be necessary in carrying out the purposes herein contained; to sell and convey lots for the purposes of interment; and to do any and all things necessary and proper for the carrying out of the purposes and objects aforesaid in their fullest and broadest sense.

3.

That the principal place where the business is to be transacted shall be Boundary County, Idaho.

4.

That the term for which it is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

5.

That the number of directors of said corporation shall be five (5).

That there shall be no capital stock in this association.
