IACS Foundation, Inc.  
Articles of Incorporation

**Article 2: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:**

The IACS Foundation, Inc. (the Foundation) is organized exclusively for the charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding other language (or provisions) in the creating document, the purposes will be limited exclusively to exempt purposes within the meaning of IRC 501(c)(3).

We agree that no part of the net earnings of the Foundation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private person, except that the organization shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Foundation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other language (or provision) in the creating document, the Foundation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

**Article 8: Upon dissolution the assets shall be distributed:**

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Idaho Arts Charter School, if the school is a qualifying organization at time of dissolution. If the Idaho Arts Charter School is not a qualifying organization at the time of dissolution, the assets shall be distributed to the Nampa School District or the State of Idaho, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
