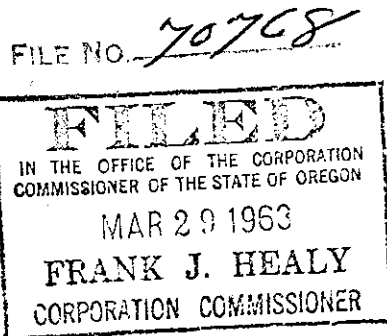

Articles of Incorporation

OF

GROESBECK-DURBIN, INC.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

① The name of this corporation is GROESBECK-DURBIN, INC.

and its duration shall be perpetual

ARTICLE II

① The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: To carry on and conduct a general construction business including, but not limited to, road and highway construction, bridge, dam, building structures and improvements, construction of all types, excavation, leveling and other land preparation, asphalt and concrete paving and any type of industrial projects or systems or public works of every description whatsoever; to make, execute, take or receive any contracts or assignments of contracts therefor or relating thereto and any documents connected therewith; to manufacture or otherwise acquire and finish all buildings and other materials and supplies connected therewith; to manufacture, produce, adapt and prepare and deal in and with any materials, articles or things incidental to or required in connection with any of its businesses; to engage in any type of manufacturing or processing, including rock crushing, quarry, concrete and asphalt, and any other materials or products incidental to a general construction business.

To engage in and carry on and conduct a general business of professional engineering.

To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise and own, hold and possess lands, premises and improvements thereto, and equipment, fixtures and personal property, including securities or choses in action of any type, for the purpose of operation of the business or for the purpose of investment or resale or any other purposes, and to deal in and with such property.

Generally to engage in and conduct any other operations, businesses or enterprises, connected therewith or incidental to any of the objects aforesaid.

In general this corporation assumes to itself and possesses the right, privilege and franchise to do any and all things necessary, convenient or desirable for the purpose of accomplishing any of the objects aforesaid and the rights, powers, franchises and privileges granted or conferred or that hereafter may be granted to or conferred upon corporations by the laws of the State of Oregon.

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ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is

One Million (1,000,000) shares of common stock of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE IV

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is Mohawk Road and 27th,

and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is H. W. Appel

ARTICLE V
