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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned,
RONALD BATH and TERRI BATH, each being of natural age and acting as
incorporators of the above named corporation under the Idaho
Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I.

The name of this corporation shall be SALMON POINT
DEVELOPMENT, INC.

II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this
corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The location of the registered office of this corporation
shall be 1 Lodge Street, Riggins, Idaho County, State of Idaho, and
the address of the registered office of the corporation shall be
the same.

IV.

The nature of the business and the objectives and purposes to
be transacted, promoted and carried out are to do any or all things
herein mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons
might or could do, in any part of the world, viz:

To purchase real estate, land, interest in land, interest in
buildings or improvements located upon land, timber and growing
crops of every kind and description and to acquire such real estate

1 by purchase or trade and to carry on the business of brokers,
2 dealers and/or financial agents and all transactions relating to
3 the sale, transfer or exchange of every kind and description of
4 real estate land or anything affixed or a part thereof, including
5 lumber, timber, or any type of forest products and to subdivide,
6 sell, apportion and develop for the purpose of resale and the
7 building of residential or recreational property of any kind and
8 description and to do and carry on all other transactions and
9 negotiations in any way by cash sales, installment sales, or any
10 other method whether on commission or otherwise relating to such
11 business and to further carry on the business of lumber and timber
12 brokers in all branches of the industry related thereto.

13 To do a general business as commission merchants, buying and
14 selling agents, and factor in the manner and to the same extent as
15 natural persons could do; to buy, sell, and otherwise deal in any
16 land, real estate, timber, lumber or any forest products, build-
17 ings, improvements, lots, subdivisions, or similar or related thing
18 within and without the United States.

19 To make and enter into all kinds of contracts, agreements and
20 obligations by or with any person or persons, corporation or
21 corporations, partnership or any business entity for the purchas-
22 ing, acquiring, holding and selling or otherwise disposing of,
23 either as principal or agent, upon commission or otherwise, all
24 land, real estate, lots, subdivisions, improvements, buildings,
25 timber, lumber and related forest products within or without the
26 United States;

27 To carry on and undertake any business, undertaking, transac-
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1 tion or operation commonly carried on or undertaken by merchants,
2 commission men, factors, importers, manufacturers, agents and
3 exporters, and in the course of such business to draw, accept,
4 endorse, acquire and sell all or any negotiable or transferable
5 instruments and securities.

6 To act as agent or representative of owners or other persons
7 or corporations having or claiming to have any interest in land,
8 real estate, lots, subdivisions, improvements, buildings, timber,
9 lumber or related forest products.

10 To enter into, make and perform and carry out contracts of
11 every sort and kind with any person, firm, association or corpora-
12 tion, municipality, body public, country, territory, district,
13 state and government.

14 To purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or
15 otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds,
16 securities or evidences of indebtedness created by, any other
17 corporation or corporations organized under the laws of this state
18 or any other state, country, nation or government, and whiled the
19 owner thereof, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of
20 ownership.

21 To apply for, secure, acquire by assignment, transfer,
22 purchase or otherwise, and to exercise, carry out and enjoy any
23 charter, license, power, authority, franchise, concessions, rights,
24 or privileges, which any government or authority or any corporation
25 or other public body may be empowered to grant; and to pay for, aid
26 in and contribute toward carrying the same into effect, and to
27 appropriate any of the corporation's shares of stocks, bonds and
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1 assets to defray the necessary costs, charges and expenses thereof.

2 To acquire, and pay for in cash, stock or bonds of this
3 corporation or otherwise, the good will, rights, assets and
4 property and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the
5 obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or
6 corporation.

7 To draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue
8 promissory notes, bills of exchange and other negotiable or
9 transferable instruments.

10 In the purchase or acquisition of property, business, rights,
11 or franchises, or for additional working capital, or any other
12 object in or about its business or affairs, and without limit as to
13 amount, incur debts and to raise, borrow and secure the payment of
14 money in any lawful manner, including the issue and sale or other
15 disposition of bonds, debentures, obligations, negotiable and
16 transferable instruments and evidence of indebtedness of all kinds,
17 whether secured by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise;

18 To carry on any other business which may seem to the corpora-
19 tion capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with
20 its business or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the
21 value of or render profitable any of the corporation's property or
22 rights.

23 The said corporation may perform any part of its business
24 outside the State of Idaho, in the other states, in the District of
25 Columbia, territories or possessions, or dependencies of the United
26 States.

27 To do each and every thing necessary, suitable, useful or
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1 advisable for the accomplishment of any one or more of the said
2 objects or which shall, at any time, appear to be conducive to or
3 expedient for the benefit of said corporation in connection
4 therewith.

5 To do each and all things set forth herein to the same extent
6 and as fully as natural persons might or could do in the State of
7 Idaho, and in any other state, country or place.

8 The foregoing clauses shall be construed as objects, purposes
9 and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that any enumera-
10 tion of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in
11 any manner the powers of this corporation.

12 In general, to carry on any other business in connection with
13 the foregoing, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by
14 laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations.

15 V.

16 In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers conferred
17 by statute, the board of directors is expressly authorized;

18 To make and alter by-laws of this corporation, to fix the
19 amount to be reserved as working capital over and above its capital
20 stock paid in, and to authorize and cause to be executed mortgages
21 and liens upon the real and personal property of this corporation.

22 If the by-laws so provided, to designate two or more of its
23 members to constitute an executive committee, which committee shall
24 for the time being, as provided in said resolution or in the by-
25 laws of this corporation, have and exercise any or all of the
26 powers of the board of directors in the management of the business
27 and affairs of this corporation, and have power to authorize the
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1 sale of this corporation to be affixed to all papers which may
2 require it.

3 Pursuant to the affirmative vote of the holders of at least a
4 majority of the stock issued and outstanding, having voting power,
5 given at a stockholders meeting duly called for that purpose, or
6 when authorized by the written consent of at least a majority of
7 the holders of the voting stock issued and outstanding, the board
8 of directors shall have power and authority at any meeting to sell,
9 lease or exchange all of the property and assets of this corpora-
10 tion, including its good will and its corporate franchises, upon
11 such terms and conditions as its board of directors deem expedient
12 and for the best interest of the corporation.

13 This corporation may in its by-laws confer powers upon its
14 directors in addition to the foregoing, and in addition to the
15 powers and authorities expressly conferred upon them by statute.

16 VI.

17 The capital stock of this corporation shall be ONE HUNDRED
18 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00), divided into ONE HUNDRED (100)
19 shares with a par value of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) each.
20 No distinction shall exist between the shares of this corporation
21 and all such shares shall have the same rights in the corporation.

22 VII.

23 All or any portion of the capital stock may be issued for cash
24 or in payment for real or personal property, services or any other
25 right or thing of value, for the uses and purposes of the corpora-
26 tion and when so issued shall become and be fully paid, the same as
27 though paid for in cash at par; and the directors shall be the sole
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1 judges of the value of any property, right, or thing acquired in
2 exchange for capital stock.

3 VIII.

4 From time to time the capital stock may be increased according
5 to laws, and may be issued in such amounts and proportions as shall
6 be determined by the board of directors, and as may be permitted by
7 law.

8 IX.

9 The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject
10 to the payment of corporate debts to any extend whatsoever.

11 X.

12 The address of the initial registered office of the corpora-
13 tion is 1 Lodge Street, Riggins, Idaho County, State of Idaho, and
14 the name of its initial registered agent is RONALD BATH, 904 North
15 Macarthur, Riggins, Idaho County, Idaho.

16 XI.

17 The number of directors constituting the initial board of
18 directors of the corporation is two (2) and the names and addresses
19 of the persons who are to serve as directors until the first annual
20 meeting of the shareholders or until their successors are elected
21 and shall qualify are:

3 right conferred upon stockholders herein are granted, subject to
4 this reservation.

7 within and without the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the laws
8 of the State of Idaho, do make, and file these Articles of
9 Incorporation, hereby declaring and certifying that the facts
