Be it known that we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under Title 30, Chapter 11, of Idaho Code Annotated, a non-profit corporation to be known as RUPERT COUNTRY CLUB, INC.

AND WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

- I -

NAME.

That the name of this corporation shall be RUPERT COUNTRY CLUB, INC.

- II -

PURPOSE OF INCORPORATION.

- 1. To operate and maintain, for the convenience and enjoyment of its members, a country club, with its attendant facilities
 for hunting, fishing, golf, tennis, horseback riding, and any and
 all other forms of recreation which may be the pleasure of its
 members in their hours of relaxation.
- 2. To construct and operate golf courses, tennis courts, ball grounds, bridle paths, bath houses, lunch houses and restaurants, hunting and fishing accommodations, dance halls, club houses and any and all other buildings and facilities which may be necessary or convenient for or promotive of the general objects and purposes of this corporation.
- 3. To receive, own, buy, sell, hold, convey, dispose of, mortgage, pledge and lease real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, hold, convey, transfer and mortgage any rights, privileges, franchises or interests in or to the real and personal property of this corporation; to borrow and lend money for any purposes of this corporation, and to make, execute, issue and deliver therefor notes, bonds, debentures or evidence of indebtedness of

any kind whatsoever and to secure the payment of the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, upon any and all property, real and personal, owned by this corporation.

- 4. To sue and be sued.
- 5. To charge such fees to the public, non-members or guests for the use and enjoyment of the grounds and property of this corporation, as the Board of Directors shall see fit, all funds so raised to be used for the improvement and beautification of the grounds and facilities under the supervision and control of this corporation.
- 6. To do any and all other acts as may be necessary, suitable, convenient or expedient to accomplish the purposes of this corporation, or for the protection, extension, development or benefit of this corporation, or any of its property.

- III -

LOCATION AND POST OFFICE ADDRESS.

That the location and post office address of this corporation and the place where its business is to be transacted is the City of Rupert, Idaho; that the place where the said country club will be located is in Minidoka County, Idaho.

- IV -

MEMBERSHIPS.

That this corporation shall have no capital stock, but shall issue a membership certificate to each of its members.

- V -

TERM OF EXISTENCE.

That the term of existence of this corporation shall be FIFTY (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.

- VI -

DIRECTORS.

That the management and control of said corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors composed of seven members, and three members of the first Board of Directors shall be elected for one-year, two members for two years and two members for three

years, and thereafter at each regular annual meeting of the members for the election of Directors, members of said Board whose terms expire shall be elected for three years. That there shall at all times be on said Board of Directors five members from Rupthere may be ert and its vicinity, and/two members at large from the surrounding territory. The duties of said directors shall be as prescribed by the by-laws of this corporation.

- VII -

FUNDS,

That this corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and no dividends shall ever be paid, and any funds received by the corporation over and above expenses of operation, shall be applied to the operation and improvement, betterment, beautifying and enlargement of the club grounds and property.

- VIII -

MANAGER.

That the Board of Directors of this corporation, may if it desire, employ a manager, whose powers and duties shall be defined and prescribed by the by-laws of this corporation.

- IX -

ELECTION OF PRESENT GOVERNING BOARD.

That certain persons have heretofore associated themselves together, and there now exists such association, known as Rupert Country Club; that said association was formed for the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation; that at a regularly celled meeting of the members of said association held on Monday May 26, 1958, in Rupert, Idaho, an election was held at which was elected a Board of Directors of this corporation; that a majority of the members of said association was present at said meeting and voted at said election; that notice of the time and place of holding said election was published in the Minidoka County News a new-spaper published twice weekly in Rupert, Idaho, on Thursday, May 15, 1958, and on Thursday, May 22, 1958, and said notice was posted in the manner provided by law; that the names of the directors
