ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of COTTONWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH, INC. A Religious Corporation

We, the undersigned, being all citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho and residents of Cottonwood or vicinity in Idaho County in said state, and being all members of the Cottonwood Baptist Church of Cottonwood, Idaho, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation pursuant to Chapter 11 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and all acts supplemental thereto and amendatory thereof, and we do hereby certify:

That at a meeting of the members of said church held at the Cottonwood Baptist Church on the north side of Front Street in Cottonwood, Idaho County, Idaho, at the hour of eight o'clock p.m., on Friday, June 24, 1966, for the purpose of forming a religious corporation of the members of said church under the name of Cottonwood Baptist Church, Inc., a regligious corporation, providing that said corporation shall have perpetual succession, adopting by-laws for said corporation and electing three trustees thereof, and for the purpose of transacting any and all other business that the members present deemed it expedient to transact in connection with said incorporation of said church, prior to which meeting and election, notice of the time and place thereof was given in the manner and form required by law, by publication for at least two weeks in the Cottonwood Chronicle, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the Town of Cottonwood, Idaho County, Idaho, a copy of which notice as printed and published is hereto attached, marked "Exhibit A" and by reference made a part hereof, and by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the door of the church where such meeting and election were held, such postings being for the same length of time, at which meeting there were <u>fourteen</u> members of said church present, the undersigned were elected trustees of said church to hold office until the election and qualification of their successors at the first annual meeting of said church

thereafter and were authorized to adopt and certify the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I (Name)

The name of this corporation shall be the "COTTONWOOD BAPTIST CHURCH, INC."

ARTICLE II (Term)

The term of existence of this corporation is unlimited, and it shall have perpetual succession and existence from and after the date of incorporation.

ARTICLE III (Purpose)

The purpose for which this corporation is formed is as follows:

To establish and maintain a church in Cottonwood, Idaho County, State of Idaho, and in connection therewith, a suitable and customary organization for the purpose of public worship and religious training under the Protestant Faith, as established and maintained by The Southern Baptist Convention of Churches; to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, manage, sell, mortgage and otherwise encumber or dispose of real or personal property of any kind whatsoever; to receive, hold and enjoy gifts, devises and legacies; to borrow money, to execute and issue notes and bonds, evidencing its indebtedness, and to secure indebtedness by pledge, mortgage or other encumbrance of its property; to rent and lease real property; to do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herein expressed, and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character, and without in any particular limiting any of the objectives or purposes or powers of the corporation, the objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to

time to do any one or more or all of the acts and things herein set forth, and all such acts, things and business in any manner connected therewith or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary thereto or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or the members thereof, or to enhance the value of any of its property or rights as such corporation, may lawfully do; and, in carrying on its objectives and purposes, or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects, to do any and all things and exercise any and all other powers not prohibited by law or the Rules and Regulations of the Southern Baptist Convention of Churches.

ARTICLE IV (Principal Office and Post Office Address)

The place where the principal office of this corporation shall be maintained and its principal place of business is at Cottonwood, Idaho County, Idaho, and the post office and registered address of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Cottonwood, Idaho.

ARTICLE V (Membership)

The members of this corporation shall be all persons who are now or who may hereafter becomes members of the Cottonwood Baptist Church.

ARTICLE VI (Trustees or Directors)

The number of trustees or directors of this corporation shall be not less than three and not more than seven persons and the number, qualification, terms of office, manner of election, time, place and manner of calling meetings shall be prescribed by the by-laws. The Board of Trustees or Directors shall have the management of the real estate and personal property of the corporation and shall be in charge of the promotion, operation and maintenance of the corporation, for the use of the members of this corporation and the properly constituted church authorities.

The following persons were elected on June 24, 1966, to serve on the Board of Trustees or Directors until the first annual meeting of the members of this corporation thereafter and until their successors are elected and qualified:
