Pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, the undersigned officers of the corporation hereby certify that the corporation adopts the following Articles of Dissolution:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Hillside Water Users, Inc.

ARTICLE II

There are no suits pending against the corporation in any court.


ARTICLE VII
