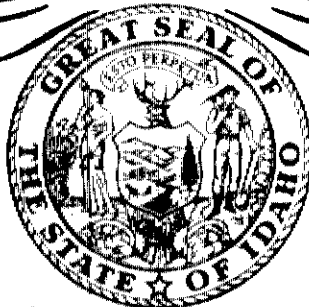

The Board met this day pursuant to notice duly published in the Wood River News-Miner:

Present: Chairman William Rember and Commissioners James King and James F. King, and Clerk W. F. Home, by Geo. A. McLeod, Deputy.

The Board having under consideration the matter of the incorporation of the town of Arco, Blaine County, Idaho, and a petition of the taxable inhabitants of said town having been presented to the Board praying for the incorporation of said town and it appearing from said petition and other evidence presented to said Board that a majority of the taxable inhabitants of said town had signed such petition for the incorporation thereof, and said Board being <sup>fully</sup> satisfied from the sworn testimony of J. E. Smith and Otto B. Fleischer and other evidence that inhabitants to the number of 200 or more are legal residents of the territory described in said petition.

It is Therefore Ordered and Declared, That the said town be and the same is hereby incorporated as a village, under the name of "THE VILLAGE OF ARCO", and that the metes and bounds thereof are hereby designated to be as follows:-

Beginning at the North East corner of the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty, Township Four North of Range Twenty-seven East, thence west to the North West corner of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township Four North of Range Twenty-six East, thence South to the South West corner of the South-east quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Four North of Range Twenty-six East, thence East to the South East corner of the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty-one, Township Four North of Range Twenty-seven East, thence North to place of beginning.

The Board having under consideration the appointment of five Trustees for the Village of Arco to serve until the election and qualification of their successors and a petition signed by numerous citizens being presented, said petition is hereby granted and the following Trustees are hereby appointed:

Otto B. Fleischer.

J. W. Clendenin.

Geo. E. Ferris.

Whereupon the Board adjourned.
