It is Therefore Ordered and Declared, That the said town be and the same is hereby incorporated as a village, under the name of "THE VILLAGE OF ARCO", and that the metes and bounds thereof are hereby designated to be as follows:-

Beginning at the North East comer of the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty, Township Four North of Range Twenty-seven East, thence west to the North West corner of the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Twenty-rive, Township Four North of Range Twenty-six East, thence South to the South West corner of the South-east quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty-six, Township Four North of Range Twenty-six East, thence East to the South East corner of the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Thirty-one, Township Four North of Range Twenty-seven East, thence North to place of beginning.
