KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, the undersigned, being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States of America, in order to form a professional corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

I.

Name

The name of the corporation shall be Ronald E. Lowry, D.D.S., M.D., P.A.

II.

Registered Office

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION-1 05/g

Duration

The period of existence and duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

v.

Corporate Purposes

- A. To render dental services; to engage in the practice of dentistry; to engage in the specialty of oral surgery, and to perform and engage in any other service ancillary to the practice of dentistry and oral surgery.
- B. To have, exercise and enjoy all of the powers now or hereafter granted to professional corporations organized under the laws of the State of Idaho, and particularly all of the powers and privileges granted to professional corporations by Chapter 13 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and any present and future amendments thereto, and to do any act or thing necessary or convenient for the transaction of the aforementioned business purposes and the carrying into effect of any and all of the aforesaid objects and purposes.

Authorized Capital Stock

The corporation shall have 1,000 shares of common stock with a par value of \$1.00 per share, for a total capitalization of \$1,000.00. Each share shall have the same rights, privileges and voting power and shall be nonassessable.

Director

There shall be one (1) director of the corporation, but the number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as provided by the By-Laws; provided, however, that the number of directors constituting the Board of Directors shall never exceed the number of licensed dentists who are stockholders of the corporation. By-Laws

The Board of Directors, by a majority vote, shall have the power to adopt By-Laws, and to repeal and amend By-Laws.

Χ.

Transfer of Stock

The transfer of stock of the corporation shall be restricted and limited as provided by the Professional Service Corporation Act of the State of Idaho, the By-Laws of the corporation, and any other agreement entered into by and between the corporation and/or its stockholder(s); provided, however, that in no event shall any person be eligible to own stock in the corporation who is not a licensed dentist under the laws of the State of Idaho, and any attempted transfer of stock to an ineligible person shall be void.
