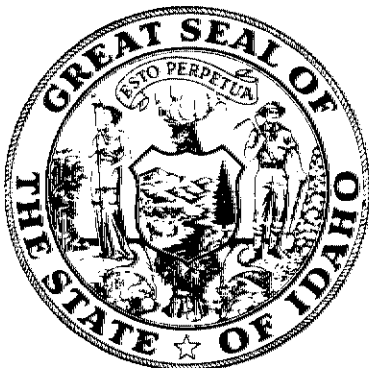

The undersigned, acting as president and secretary of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Dissolution of such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Munoz-Quintana Educational Services, Inc. The post-office address of the corporation is 116 14th Ave. South, Nampa, Idaho 83651.

SECOND: The names and addresses of the last officers and directors of the corporation and their respective offices are as follows:

THIRD: The corporation gave notice of its dissolution to each of its actual and potential creditors not less than 30 days prior to filing the Articles of Dissolution as required by section 30-1-87 of the Idaho Code.

FOURTH: All debts, obligations and liabilities of the corporation have been paid and discharged.

FIFTH: All remaining property and assets of the corporation have been distributed in accordance with the distribution provision in the Articles of Incorporation, that is, all remaining property and assets of the corporation have been distributed to a nonprofit organization which has established its tax exempt status under section 503(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

SIXTH: There are no suits pending against the corporation in any court.

SEVENTH: At a meeting of the Board of Directors of Munoz-Quintana Educational Services, Inc. on December 1, 1988, the Board of Directors adopted a resolution to recommend that the corporation be dissolved. The resolution received a unanimous vote. The corporation has no shareholders. The Articles of Dissolution is pursuant to the resolution to dissolve adopted in the manner required by section 30-1-84 of the Idaho Code and were unanimously adopted January 15, 1989 by the Board of Directors at a meeting of the members of the corporation.
