

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Troy Motors, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to transact the businesses of an automobile, truck and other motor driven vehicles repair shop and any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is ---FIFTY--- THOUSAND (50,000) shares, of a par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) per share.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 509 S. Main, Troy, Idaho 83871; and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Kenneth G. Whitney.
