ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MARIPOSA FOUNDATION FOR CONSERVATION, INC.
A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, natural persons of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, and as citizens of the United States of America, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho, as contained in Chapter 3, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, entitled "Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act," do hereby set forth:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is the MARIPOSA FOUNDATION FOR CONSERVATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is intended to be and will be a nonprofit Corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes for which the Corporation is to be formed and organized are for scientific, educational, and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and is to be an agricultural and/or horticultural

organization within the meaning of Section 501(c)(5) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, the purposes of which also are: to promote the protection and preservation of plant life, to prevent diminishing plant life and species from becoming extinct, and to enforce or assist in enforcement of all laws and regulations protecting and preserving plant life in general and diminishing species of plant life in particular.

ARTICLE V

The Corporation will be a membership corporation, the member and designation of classes, the manner and election and appointment, and qualification of right of said members to be set forth in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VI
