St. Anthony, Idaho, Nov. 15th, 1916.

As per adjournment of the 13th inst. the Board of County Commissioners convened.  
All members of the Board were present and the following proceedings were had:

It is hereby ordered that until February 1st 1917, Esther Alderson of Dubois be allowed and is hereby allowed \$36.00 per month, and it is ordered that a warrant issue to her monthly for the same to aid in the support of herself and her minor children.

In the Matter of the Petition of

James T. Gayle, et al,  
for the incorporation of the Village of Dubois, with the Boundaries hereinafter defined.

The Board having had the same under consideration find that said petition is signed by a majority of the taxable inhabitants of the Town of Dubois, and of the territory which it is proposed to incorporate in the Village of Dubois.

That there are 200 and more inhabitants who are actual residents of the territory described in the petition.

It is, therefore, ordered that said Town of Dubois be incorporated as a village under the name "Village of Dubois". Said incorporated village to include the following described territory:

Beginning at a point 80 rods South of the North line of Section 21, Township 10, North, of Range 36 East of Boise Meridian on the East Right of Way line of the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, and running thence West to a point 10 rods West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 20 in Township 10 North of Range 36 East of Boise Meridian, and thence running due South 1 mile; thence East to the East line of the right of way of the main line of the Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, thence North along the East line of said right of way to the place of beginning.

It is further ordered that James T. Gayle, C.H. Oakley, L.D. Reynolds, Joseph Laird and David Thomas be and they are appointed Trustees of said Village.

Ordered that this Board adjourn until December 4th, 1916.
