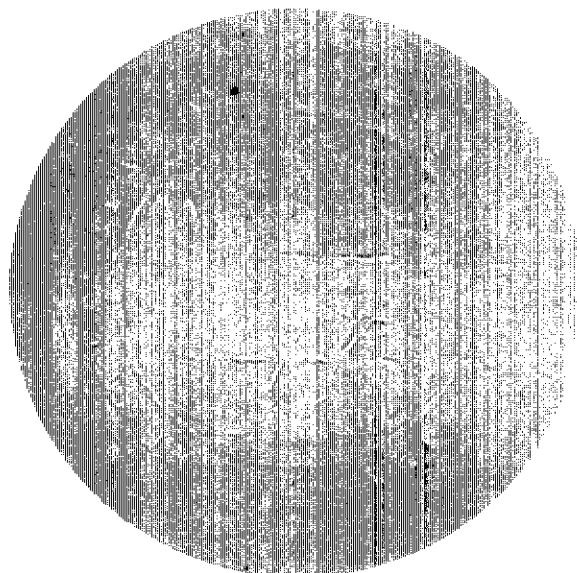
CERTIFICATE OF GOOD STANDING
