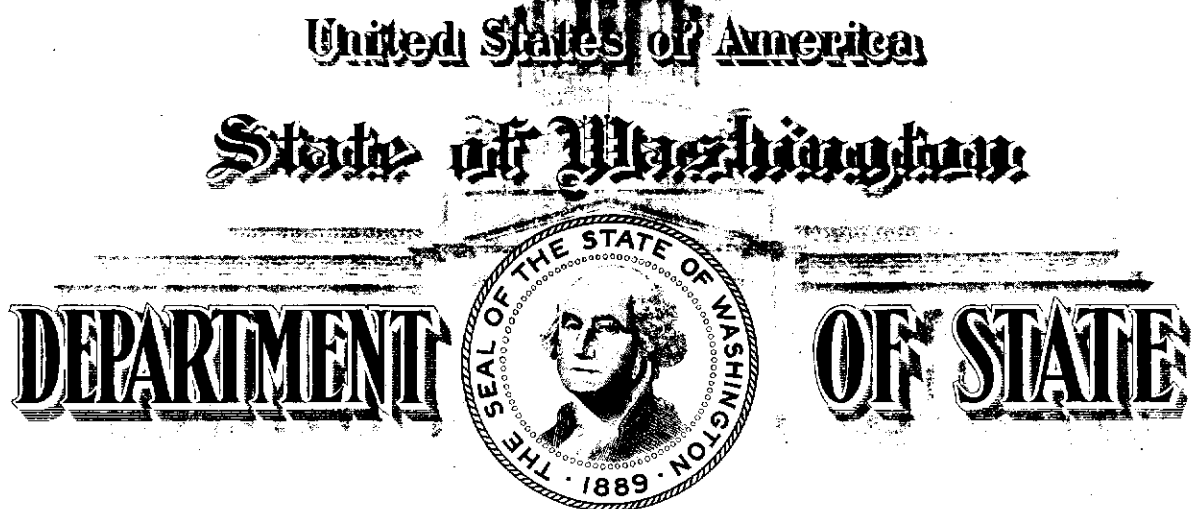

COME FOR the undersigned, JOSEPH A. ALBI, President, GUY FOWELL, Secretary, and Del Cary Smith, William Rusch, Ned Barnes, Albin Pearson, and Clerk Erwin, a majority of the Board of Trustees of the ATHLETIC ROUND TABLE, each for himself being first duly sworn on oath deposes, and says:

That: there is attached hereto, and made a part of this Certificate, a true copy of the Agreement of Association, of the ATHLETIC ROUND TABLE, and that thereon appear the names of the subscribers; that the date of the first meeting of the said subscribers, was the 8th day of January 1936; that the undersigned have met on this 24th day of January 1936 for the purpose of executing this Certificate so that the same may be filed with the County Auditor of Spokane, County, and the Office of the Secretary of State for Washington, at Olympia, Washington.

On this date, the undersigned have resolved to petition the Secretary of State for Washington for a Charter establishing the existence of the ATHLETIC ROUND TABLE as a corporation, with power to act within the limitations, duties, and restrictions, expressed in their articles of agreement.

That on January 6, 1936, the undersigned, all of whom were present at the first meeting of the subscribers to the attached Articles of Agreement, adjourned the said first meeting, to meet Tuesday January 14, 1936, for reasons of convenience; the said adjourned meeting was again adjourned for the same reasons to be held in the "Athletic Round Table" luncheon room, at 5 P. M. on January 24, 1936.

CHARTER
and
ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT

* * * *

BE IT KNOWN, that by virtue of Sections 3873 to 3877 of Remington's Revised Statutes of Washington, we the undersigned, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Washington, having previously associated ourselves, and with others for over 15 years last past, do formally on this day, associate ourselves with the intention of forming a corporation wherein we do declare the following

ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT
(in triplicate)

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be the
ATHLETIC ROUND TABLE, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows, to-wit:

- 1- To promote sports throughout the Inland Empire, by assisting in athletic contests, particularly in the game of football; to arrange athletic matches and competitions, and to offer and grant or contribute towards the provision of prizes, awards, and distinctions; to co-operate with colleges and other associations whose objects are similar to our own.
- 2- To raise money by subscription, grant any rights and privileges to subscribers.
- 3- To provide refreshment rooms and other conveniences in connection therewith, and with a view thereto of enjoying the reception of radio broadcasting of athletic events and the broadcasting of announcements concerning games of interest and importance throughout the Inland Empire.
- 4- To promote social fellowship and companionship among our members by daily contacts with each other and with coaches and contestants, and to this end to furnish a place where meetings may be held, where decisions of the day may be discussed, where important announcements may be engaged in, with privileges of providing and furnishing at any and all times, to its members, its honorary members, their wives and guests, for pay, refreshments of any and all kinds, cigars, cigarettes and tobaccos, and any beverages commonly known as soda waters, mineral waters, ales, foundations, and the like.

5- To rent, own, or operate locations for the staging of Athletic events.

ARTICLE III

This corporation shall not have any capital stock, nor issue shares of stock to its members and the same is declared to be a non profit organization, and such profits as may be accumulated shall be spent in the purposes for which we are associated.

ARTICLE IV

The headquarters of the organization, and its meeting and club rooms shall be located in our present and past headquarters in the Dessert Hotel, Spokane, Washington.

ARTICLE V

The names and Post office addresses of those associating in the formal adoption of this Charter and Articles of agreement are the undersigned organizers who have hereunto set their hands and seals to this agreement in triplicate on this 21st day of December, 1935.
