# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

WOOD RIVER JUNIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION, INC.

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

#### ARTICLE I

#### NAME

The name of the corporation is WOOD RIVER JUNIOR GOLF ASSOCIATION, INC. (hereinafter called "Corporation.").

# ARTICLE II

# PRINCIPAL AND REGISTERED AGENT

The location and principal office of the Corporation is Bigwood Golf Course, Highway 75 and Saddle Road, Ketchum, Idaho, and the post office address is Post Office Box 249, Ketchum, Idaho, 83340. The registered agent of the Association is William Casey, whose/address is 105 Deer Run Road, Ketchum, Idaho, and whose Post Office address is Post Office Box 538, Sun Valley, Idaho.

#### ARTICLE III

# INCORPORATORS

# ARTICLE IV

#### PURPOSE AND POWERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The purposes for which the Association is formed are:

a. The corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and its assets are dedicated to these purposes. Its specific and primary purpose shall be to conduct clinics, workshops and lessons for children between the ages of seven and seventeen to instruct and educate them

in the sport of golf. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

- b. The general purpose and power of the corporation is:
- 1. To raise funds through contributions by the general public for the maintenance of low-cost clinics and golf lessons for children in the Wood River Valley, Idaho between the ages of seven and seventeen and to conduct clinics, workshops and golf lessons for those children.
- 2. To have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of Idaho by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.

The foregoing statement of purposes shall be construed as a statement both of purposes and of powers, and purposes and powers in each clause shall in no wise be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms or provisions of any other clause, but shall be broadly construed as independent purposes and powers.

Notwithstanding any of the above statements of purposes and powers, the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the primary purposes of the Corporation.

#### ARTICLE V

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

The corporation shall have one class of members composed of those persons appointed by the Board of Directors which members shall elect the Board of Directors and be eliqible to serve as a director.

# ARTICLE VI

#### BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Corporation shall initially be managed by a board of nine (9) directors. The number of directors may be changed by amendment of the Corporation.

### ARTICLE VIII

#### DISSOLUTION

Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation or a corporation which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
