

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

We, the subscribers, L. J. RAEF, a citizen and resident of Spokane, Washington, D. T. HUFFMAN, a citizen and resident of Spokane, Washington, and J. L. MAGNEY, a citizen and resident of Deary, Idaho, hereby certify that we do voluntarily associate ourselves as a private business corporation, under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 1, Title IV, of Part Second (Civil Code) of the State of Idaho, 1909, and acts amendatory thereof; and set forth:

FIRST: That the name of the corporation is

"BLUEBIRD MINING & REFINING COMPANY".

SECOND: That the purpose for which the corporation is formed is to conduct the business of:

1. Mining, smelting, refining, reducing, and dealing in and with all sorts of ores, metals and minerals, and the prospecting, locating, opening, operating and developing of mines, quarries, and mineral deposits of all descriptions.

2. Constructing, owning and operating mines, tramways, mills, factories, machine shops, and industrial plants of all descriptions, and the buying, selling and dealing in and with all supplies, merchandise and materials, raw and prepared, useful or convenient in connection therewith.

3. Acquiring, owning, leasing, dealing in, and disposing of real estate, mines, mills, mill sites, timber and mineral locations, and mining and industrial stocks, bonds and securities.

THIRD: That the place where the principal business of the corporation is to be transacted is Fairfield, Blaine County, Idaho, but meetings of the Board of Directors may be held for the transaction of any of the business of the corporation in Spokane, Washington, and other branch offices may be located within and without the State, where the corporation may hold meetings of its Directors; and the corporation may do business in any part of the world.

FOURTH: That the term for which the corporation is to exist shall be fifty years.

FIFTH: That the number of the Directors of the corporation

shall be five, and the corporation shall have such other officers as may be prescribed by law or the By-Laws of the corporation.

SIXTH: That the amount of the capital stock of the corporation shall be and is \$150,000.00, divided into 300,000 shares of the par value of 50¢ each.

SEVENTH: The amount of the capital stock of the corporation actually subscribed is \$120,020 shares, of which 120,000 shares have been subscribed for by L. J. Raef, 10 shares by D. T. Huffman and 10 shares by J. L. Magney.
