Addendum to Articles of Incorporation (Nonprofit)  
Lake Pend Oreille Waterkeeper:

**Article 2:** Lake Pend Oreille Waterkeeper is organized exclusively for the following purposes:

1. Through education, partnership and advocacy, to protect the water quality of Lake Pend Oreille, as well as to improve the health and viability of the people and ecosystems which rely upon or live close to Lake Pend Oreille.
2. To operate exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

**Article 8:** Upon dissolution the assets shall be distributed:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
