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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KIMBERLY CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INC.

We, the undersigned residents of the State of Idaho, being 18 years or more of age, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE ONE

NAME AND LOCATION

The name of the corporation shall be KIMBERLY CHRISTIAN CHURCH, INC., and its location shall be 307 Madison East, P. O. Box 98, Kimberly, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE TWO

DURATION

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE

PURPOSE CLAUSE

A. The business and purpose of this corporation shall be as revealed in the New Testament, to win people to faith in Jesus Christ and commit them actively to the church, to help them grow in the grace and knowledge of Christ that increasingly they may know and do his will, and

to work for the unity of all Christians and with them engage in the common task of building the Kingdom of God and to transact such lawful business as the Board of Directors shall from time to time determine.

- B. Charitable, religious, educational, or scientific within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under such Section 501(c)(3).
