STATE OF IDAHO

On April 24, 1999, the membership of the Mini-Cassia Community Christian Church voted to amend the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE VII, DISSOLUTION

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or religious purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall ever inure to or for the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private person except that the corporation shall be empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the exempt purposes for which it was formed.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

The amendment was unanimously approved by a vote of the 42 eligible members.
