ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

B.J.H. LAND DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC.

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, persons of the age of twentyone years, or more, and all being citizens of the United States
of America, and residents thereof, and residents of the State
of Idaho, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves for the
purpose of forming a corporation in conformity with the laws of
the State of Idaho, and for the purposes hereinafter set forth,
do hereby adopt Articles of Incorporation as follows:

I. (NAME)

The name of this corporation shall be B. J. H. Land Development Company, Inc.

II.

(LOCATION AND POST OFFICE ADDRESS)

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho, is at Orofino, County of Clearwater, State of Idaho.

III.

(DURATION)

The term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual from the date of filing the Articles of Incorporation in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho.

IV.
(PURPOSES)

1. To take, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire and to own, use, hold, sell, convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, work, improve, develop, divide and otherwise handle, deal in and dispose

of real estate, real property and any interest or right therein.

2. To take, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own,
hold, sell, convey, exchange, hire, lease, pledge, mortgage and

otherwise deal in and dispose of such personal property, chattels, rights, easements, privileges, choses in action, notes, bonds,

mortgages and securities as may be lawfully acquired, held or

disposed of by it under the laws of the State of Idaho.

3. To erect, construct, maintain, improve, rebuild, enlarge, alter, manage and control, directly or through ownership
of stock of any corporation, any and all kinds of buildings,
houses, stores, offices, shops, warehouses, factories, mills,
machinery, plants and any and all other structures which may,
in the judgment of the Board of Directors, at any time be necessary,
useful or advantageous for the purposes of the corporation, and
which can lawfully be done under the laws of the State of Idaho.

- 4. To make, enter into, perform and carry out contracts for constructing, building, altering, improving, repairing, decorating, maintaining, furnishing and fitting of buildings, tenements and structures of every description, and to advance money to and enter into agreements of all kinds with builders, contractors, property owners and others for said purposes.
- 5. To transact the business of buying and selling, dealing in, leasing, renting and managing real estate and any interests therein for its own account or for the account of others; to collect rents and to make repairs and transact the general business of a real estate agent.
- 6. To purchase, sell, manufacture and deal in building materials and goods, wares and merchandise, and to carry on any other lawful trade or business incident or proper for use in

connection with the purchase, sale, ownership, construction, maintenance and management of real property.

- 7. To make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and description pertaining to the purposes of this corporation and for any lawful purposes necessary and expedient thereto, with any person, firm, association or corporation. To borrow or raise money without limit as to amount by negotiable or transferrable instruments, or otherwise, to make and perform contracts of every kind and description in carrying out the business of the corporation, or for the purpose of obtaining or furthering any of its objects.
- 8. The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to do any and all things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, and in any part of the world as principal, agent, through agencies, licensees, or otherwise, and in furtherance, and not in limitation, of the general powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho.

## (AMOUNT OF CAPITAL STOCK)

The total authorized number of par value shares of stock is one thousand (1,000). Each share shall have one (1) vote. The aggregate par value of the total authorized number of par shares is One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). Each share shall have a par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each share shall be considered common stock and there shall be no preferred stock.

IX.

(AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION)

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a

majority vote of the stock issued at any regular meeting, or at a special meeting called for that purpose by a majority of the Board of Directors, after thirty (30) days notice to all holders of stock, which notice shall be in conformance with the statutes of the State of Idaho, made and provided therefor.
