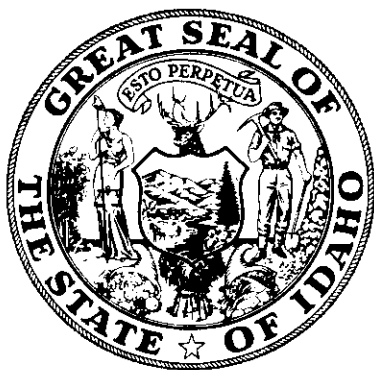

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
IDAHO'S JUNIOR MISS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 30-31 et. seq.  
of the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act:

1. The name of this corporation shall be Idaho's Junior Miss Scholarship Program, Inc.
2. This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and no part of its income shall be distributed to its members, directors or officers.
3. The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.
4. The purpose of this corporation shall be:
  - a. to promote, encourage, stimulate and foster among Idaho's young women an interest in scholarship, physical fitness, the creative and performing arts, and poise and appearance through the award of educational scholarships to qualified contestants of the Idaho Junior Miss Pageant;
  - b. to provide for the administration, supervision, control and conduct of the Idaho Junior Miss Pageant;
  - c. to provide for the administration, supervision, control and payment of the Idaho Junior Miss Scholarships;
  - d. to promote, encourage, stimulate and foster good will and publicity for the State of Idaho and its citizens through the recognition of Idaho's outstanding young women;
  - e. such other activities as are consistent with the purposes stated above and the provisions of the

Idaho Code.

5. The Registered Agent of this corporation shall be Nancy Blacker. Location and mailing address of its Registered Office shall be <sup>219 N. LILLY ST, MOSCOW, ID 83843</sup> <sup>219 N. LILLY ST,</sup> P.O. Box 8819, Moscow, Idaho 83843.

6. The number of directors on the initial board shall be five (5).

7. The initial directors shall be:

8. The existing directors shall elect the successor directors in accordance with the bylaws of the corporation.

9. Upon dissolution of this corporation, all assets remaining after payment and discharge of all known debts, obligations and liabilities of the corporation shall be distributed to an organization or organizations qualifying for tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
