Second. That the purposes for which it is formed, is to carry on  
a busines s of mining for Gold, Silver, Copper and other precious metals,  
to own, buy, sell, control and operate mines and mining claims, and all  
kinds of real e state, and to do every act and thing in the nature of  
barter and sale that become necessary for the transaction of a general  
Mining Business.

Third, That the place of its general business shall be transacted  
is in the Town of Rathdrum, Kootenai County, State of Idaho.
