ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FIRST COMMUNITY CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

We, the undersigned, Moderator and Clerk of First Community Congregational Church, a religious corporation, do hereby certify that at meetings of the members of said corporation, duly called and held according to provisions of Section 30-1103, and Section 30,1104, Idaho Code, and held at 4821 Franklin Road, City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho, the resolutions as hereinafter set forth were adopted by a majority vote of the members then present.

On the 12th day of January, 1964, at the hour of 1:30 o'clock P.M.:

RESOLVED That Article 4 of the Articles of Incorporation do, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

"That the term for which it is to exist is perpetually."

On the 1st day of November, 1964, at the hour of 1:30 o'clock P.M.:

RESOLVED That Article 2 of the Articles of Incorporation do, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

"That the purpose for which it is formed is the promotion of Christian instruction and the support of the public worship of God in accordance with the doctrines and polity of the churches represented in the General Synod of the United Church of Christ in America, its successors and/or assigns."

RESOLVED That our Moderator and Clerk of this corporation do, and they hereby are, authorized to sign, execute, and acknowledge a certificate under the corporate seal of this corporation, replacing the foregoing resolutions and resolve that such certificate shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State as required by law.
