 AMPHDED ARTICLES OF INCOPPORATION

NEW PLYMOUTH JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

NOW KNOWN AS: NEW PLYMOUTH JAYCEES, INC.

That the Articles of Incorporation of the New Plymouth Junior Chamber of Commerce, Inc., a non-profit, benevolent and charitable corporation heretofore incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho are amended to read as follows:

Article I

The name of this corporation shall be New Plymouth Jaycees, Inc.

Article II

Section 1. Purposes. The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to provide leadership training for young men between the ages of 21 and 35 and to render civic services for the promotion of the welfare of the community and its citizens by means of active participation in projects designed to improve the community, state and nation. The purpose shall not be the protection, promotion, or stimulation of any business organized for profit, nor for participation to any extent in a political campaign for or against any candidate for public office.

To carry out the purposes hereinabove set forth, this corporation shall have and exercise all powers conferred by the law of the State of Idaho upon like corporations which are consistent with and permissible to organizations exempt by law under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and amendments thereto.

Section 2. Statutory Powers. Subject to any specific written limitation or restrictions imposed by the laws of the State of Idaho, by other law or by-laws of the corporation, and solely in furtherance of but not in addition to the purposes set forth in Section 1 of this Article, the corporation shall have and exercise all the powers specified in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code, and Chapter I, Title 30, Idaho Code.

Article III

Upon dissolution of this corporation, all the corporate assets shall
