WHEREAS, there was heretofore issued by the Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, a Certificate of Incorporation constituting Junior Chamber of Commerce, Inc., a non-profit, benevolent and charitable corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

The undersigned, Vern Coiner, the duly elected, qualified and acting President of such corporation, and the presiding officer at the meeting herein-after mentioned, and John Dolphus the duly elected, qualified and acting secretary of such corporation, who acted as such at the meeting hereinafter mentioned, do hereby certify as follows:

That the Notice of Intent to Amend Articles of Incorporation hereto, was published once a week for at least four consecutive weeks in the Payette Valley Sentinel, a newspaper published in Payette County, Idaho, the county in which the meetings hereinafter referred to were held, the first publication being on the 9th day of November, 1967, and the last publication being on the 30th day of November, 1967, as shown by the Affidavit of Publisher of said newspaper lodged with the minutes of this corporation.

That as provided in said notice a regular meeting of the corporation was held on the 30th day of November, 1967, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. at Jaycee Hall in New Plymouth, Idaho. That at such meeting all members present were polled and a majority thereof voted in favor of such amendment; that thereby the Articles of Incorporation of New Plymouth Jaycees, Inc. were amended to read as set forth in the Articles of Amendment attached thereto and thereby incorporated herein:

2 AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
3 NEW PLYMOUTH JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.
4 NOW KNOWN AS: NEW PLYMOUTH JAYCEES, INC.
5

6 That the Articles of Incorporation of the New Plymouth Junior Chamber
7 of Commerce, Inc., a non-profit, benevolent and charitable corporation heretofore
8 incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho are amended to read as follows:
9

10 Article I

11 The name of this corporation shall be New Plymouth Jaycees, Inc.

12 Article II

13 Section 1. Purposes. The purposes for which this corporation is formed
14 are to provide leadership training for young men between the ages of 21 and 35
15 and to render civic services for the promotion of the welfare of the community
16 and its citizens by means of active participation in projects designed to
17 improve the community, state and nation. The purpose shall not be the protection,
18 promotion, or stimulation of any business organized for profit, nor for partici-
19 pation to any extent in a political campaign for or against any candidate for
20 public office.

21 To carry out the purposes hereinabove set forth, this corporation shall
22 have and exercise all powers conferred by the law of the State of Idaho upon
23 like corporations which are consistent with and permissible to organizations
24 exempt by law under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal
25 Revenue Code of 1954 and amendments thereto.

26 Section 2. Statutory Powers. Subject to any specific written limita-
27 tion or restrictions imposed by the laws of the State of Idaho, by other law
28 or by-laws of the corporation, and solely in furtherance of but not in addition
29 to the purposes set forth in Section 1 of this Article, the corporation shall
30 have and exercise all the powers specified in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code,
31 and Chapter I, Title 30, Idaho Code.

32 Article III

Upon dissolution of this corporation, all the corporate assets shall
