ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 11 of Title 30, Idaho Code, and to that end do hereby adopt and execute the following Articles of Incorporation and do hereby certify and declare:

I.

That the name of said non-profit corporation is and shall be "JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, INC."

II.

The objects, purposes and powers of this corporation are: ✓

1. To encourage, promote, supervise and develop, on a non-profit basis, an educational program designed to give youths between the ages of 15 and 21 years experience in industry and business by making it possible for them to learn by doing; to provide these boys and girls, regardless of race, color or creed, with an opportunity to learn a craft, the art of buying and selling, the procedures of accounting, as well as the human relations problems faced by both employee and employer; and to install in these young participants a degree of responsibility for the successful functioning of American ✓ business and government during the years in which they will administer.

2. To engage in any activity that is or appears to be necessary or convenient in connection with the above mentioned purposes.

III.

The original members of this corporation shall be the incorporators and future members shall be admitted to membership in the corporation in accordance with the By-Laws of this corporation.

IV.

The corporation shall have its registered office in the City of Twin Falls, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho, and the post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho is Box 752, Twin Falls, Idaho

V.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is perpetual from and after the date of its incorporation.

VI.

1. Said corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of not less than thirteen members.

2. Its officers shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer or Secretary-Treasurer, who shall be elected or appointed as provided in the By-Laws of this corporation.

3. The corporation shall not issue any capital stock.

VII.

The corporation shall be operated on a non-profit basis. It is not anticipated that there will be a profit or surplus, but if such a profit or surplus does in fact occur, then such profit or surplus shall be used to further the objects and purposes of the corporation; provided, however, that in no event shall the profits or surplus of the corporation be paid to the members of the corporation.

VIII.

That in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-1102, Idaho Code, an election was held on the 16th day of November, 1965, for the purpose of electing thirteen Directors of the Board of Directors under which said corporation elects to operate, said election being held at 12:00 noon at the Desert Room of the Rogerson Hotel, Twin Falls, Idaho; that a notice of the time and place of the holding of said election of Directors was given by publication of a notice to said effect for two consecutive weeks, to-wit: November 2 and 9, 1965, in the Twin Falls Times-News, a newspaper published in said City and County of Twin Falls, Idaho; and by posting a like notice for the samelength of time in a conspicuous place at the Desert Room of the Rogerson Hotel in Twin Falls County, Idaho, where said election was held; a majority of the members present voted for and there were elected as Directors of said corporation, the following persons, to-wit:

That this corporation shall have the right to adopt a set of By-Laws in accordance with the provisions of Section 30-1108, Idaho Code.

X.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any manner at any regular meeting of the members of this corporation by a vote of a majority of a quorum attending such meeting provided public notice of the intention to amend the Articles of Incorporation shall have been given by publication at least once a week for four weeks in a newspaper published in Twin Falls County, Idaho. The published notice shall designate the regular meeting at which it is intended to vote on the proposition of amending the Articles of Incorporation, and shall state the manner in which it is intended to amend the Articles of Incorporation and the time and place of said regular meeting.
