ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
WHITE OTTER OUTDOOR ADVENTURES, INC.

1. The name of the corporation is White Otter Outdoor Adventures, Inc.
2. The period of its duration is perpetual.
3. The purpose of the corporation is the transaction of any and all lawful businesses for which corporations may be incorporated under the Corporation Act of the State of Idaho.
4. The corporation shall have authority to issue 500 shares, having no par value.
5. The address of its initial registered office is 101 Southern Comfort, Ketchum, Idaho. The name of its initial registered agent at such address is Randy Hess.
6. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors is one. He is: Randy Hess, 101 Southern Comfort, Ketchum, Idaho.
