ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

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FRIENDS OF HOSPICE, INC.

SEURETARY OF STATE

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be Friends of Hospice, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV.

The corporation is formed for the following purposes:

- a) To promote, perform, receive, and to engage in any and all activities related to the function of campaigning, soliciting, managing, and expending funds needed to provide HOSPICE services.
- b) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, sell, convey, lease, morgage and/or lease, real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage, and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise as a corporation.
- c) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for every lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state or government, and to engage in association with other corporations, partnerships, associations and individuals in joint HOSPICE activities.
- d) To excercise such incidental powers as may reasonably be necessary to carry out the purposes and business for which this corporation is established, provided that such incidental powers shall be excericised in a manner consistent with tax-excempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, of the United States of America.

Notwithstanding any provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not engage in any activity proscribed by Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, of the United States of America.

ARTICLE V.

The number of Board of Directors shall be at least three (3) and no more than five (5).

The first Board of Directors shall consist of the following:

Gary L. Thietten, Joann G. Shotwell, and Adelia Alldritt.

The qualifications, duties, powers, limitations, and other factors relevant to the functioning of the Board of Directors may be set out in the By-Laws of this corporation, subject to the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VI.

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall have the power to repeal and amend By-Laws of this corporation, and shall have the power to adopt new By-Laws; this power may be excercised by the Board of Directors through a majority vote of that Board.
