I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WE, the undersigned, all of whom are more than 21 years of age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under and pursuant to Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code and we do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this association shall be "GOODWILL INDUSTRIES OF IDAHO, INC."

ARTICLE II

The term of existence of this association is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes and objects for which this association is formed are:

A. To provide rehabilitation services, training, employment, and opportunities for personal growth as an interim step in the rehabilitation process for the handicapped, disabled, and disadvantaged who cannot be readily absorbed in the competitive labor market or during such time as employment opportunities for them in the competitive labor market do not exist;

B. By the inspiration of religion through the skillful use of recognized techniques of rehabilitation, social work, life guidance, evaluation, training and useful

employment to assist the handicapped, the disabled, and the disadvantaged to attain the fullest development of which they are capable.

C. This corporation is organized and to be operated exclusively for religious, charitable, and educational purposes. It is not organized for profit nor shall any of its net earnings inure in whole or part to the benefit of private stockholders, members or individuals. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation is attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise, nor participating in any political campaign in behalf of any candidate for public office.

It shall provide rehabilitation services, training, employment, and opportunities for personal growth as an interim step in the rehabilitation process for the handicapped, disabled and the disadvantaged who cannot be readily absorbed in the competitive labor market or during such time as employment opportunities for them in the competitive labor market do not exist. By the inspiration of religion through the skillful use of recognized techniques of rehabilitation, social work, life guidance, evaluation, training and useful employment, this corporation shall seek to assist the handicapped, the disabled, and the disadvantaged to attain the fullest development of which they are capable.

The selling of articles reconditioned, assembled, or made by such persons as a part of their vocational rehabilitation shall be a necessary part of the religious, social and educational service program of this corporation.

The association is organized and shall be operated exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes, and it is not organized for profit nor shall any

of its net earnings inure in whole or part to the benefit of any director or member. The best interests of the association shall only embrace the means necessary to carry out the association's purposes.

ARTICLE IV

The location and address of this association shall be Boise, Ada County, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the association shall be administered by a Board of Directors. The number and terms of the members of the Board of Directors shall be determined by the By-Laws of this association.

ARTICLE VII

There is no corporate stock and there are no shares of stock of this association. The rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

ARTICLE VIII

The private property of the members of the association shall be exempt from association debts.

ARTICLE IX

In case the work of this corporation shall be abandoned, or the corporation be dissolved all title to real and personal property of this corporation remaining after the debts of this corporation have been paid, shall immediately be vested in Goodwill Industries of America, Inc., for similar work in Idaho.
