## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

# MINI-CASSIA PROP BUSTERS, INC.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States and the State of Idaho, over the age of twenty-one years, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of organizing and establishing a non-profit cooperative association under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I

#### Name

The name of the cooperative association hereby organized shall be the MINI-CASSIA PROP BUSTERS, INC.

#### ARTICLE II

## Period of Duration

That the non-profit cooperative association hereby organized shall have perpetual existence.

### ARTICLE III

#### Purposes

The objects and purposes for which this cooperative association is organized are as follows:

- (1) To promote model building and flying in the City of Rupert, Minidoka County, Idaho, and in the surrounding locality.
- (2) To aid, insofar as possible, the national program of the Academy of Model Aeronautics and other AMA activities, looking toward the continual advancement of model aviation in all its phases in the United States.
- (3) All special and local enterprises of the Mini-Cassia Prop Busters, Inc. shall conform with the policies of the Academy of Model Aeronautics and to the regulations of that organization governing model aircraft contests.

#### ARTICLE IV

# Location of Corporate Offices

The cooperative association is formed without purpose of pecuniary profit, with its offices located at Rupert, Minidoka County, Idaho.

### ARTICLE V

#### Membership

In such cooperative association the rights and interests of all members shall be equal; and all persons living in Rupert, Idaho, or in the surrounding area, shall be eligible to membership in the Mini-Cassia Prop Busters, Inc., provided they meet the qualifications described and set forth by the By-Laws of this cooperative association.

No member shall have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

The cooperative association shall not issue any capital stock but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates cannot be assigned so that the transferee thereof can, by such transfer, become a member of the cooperative association except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the By-Laws may prescribe. The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the cooperative association, property, voting, and all other rights and privileges of membership, and the liability of each or all memberships to dues and assessments, and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth by the By-Laws of this cooperative association.
