We, M. A. Houston, President and Virginia Douthett, Secretary of HOME LUMBER AND COAL COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Idaho, the principal place of transacting business of this corporation being located in Boise, Ada County, Idaho, do hereby certify that at a special meeting of the Board of Directors of said corporation held on the 9th day of May, 1963, the following resolution, amending its Articles of Incorporation, was unanimously adopted:

"BE IT RESOLVED that the existence of this Corporation be changed from a period of fifty (50) years to perpetual and that Article VII of the Articles of Incorporation be amended to read as follows:

"Article VII. The existence of this Corporation shall be perpetual."

That thereafter, pursuant to said resolution and in accordance with the by-laws and the laws of the State of Idaho, said directors called a meeting of stockholders for the consideration of said amendment and thereafter, pursuant to said notice, a meeting of the stockholders was held on the 22nd day of May, 1963, to consider said proposed amendment.

That at said meeting the stockholders representing all of the outstanding stock of the Corporation voted for the proposed amendment and said amendment was duly adopted in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Idaho.
