The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be FMC EMPLOYEES BENEFIT ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit or gain. There shall be no capital stock. The initial registered agent of the corporation is Alma R. Nelson, 561 Roosevelt, American Falls, Idaho, 83211.

ARTICLE V

This corporation shall have the management vested in the Board of Directors, consisting of six directors.

ARTICLE VI

The purpose of this corporation is to represent the

interests of the employees of FMC Corporation, to do all things necessary to accomplish such purposes, including but not necessarily limited to charitable, benevolent purposes, such as distribution of candy, holiday give-aways, employee functions and sports activities.

ARTICLE VII

There shall be one class of membership in this corporation and each member shall be entitled to one vote.

ARTICLE VIII

All of the incorporators subscribed hereto are of full age and are citizens of the United States.

ARTICLE IX

This organization shall have powers to lease, purchase, hold, and sell or convey property and to enter into any business transaction necessary for corporation purposes.

ARTICLE X

Officers and Directors of this organization shall be elected by the members at the annual meeting. The number of officers and directors and all other matters relating to the management of the corporation shall be set out in the bylaws.

ARTICLE XI

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that this Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to reimburse members for out of pocket expenses incurred on behalf of the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

ARTICLE XII

The undersigned incorporators shall act as and shall constitute the initial Board of Directors until the first annual meeting and election is held.

ARTICLE XIII

These Articles may be altered and amended at any meeting of the organization providing a quorum is present, by a majority vote of the members present at such meeting.

ARTICLE XIV

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organizations created and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under subsection 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provision of any future State internal revenue law, as the Board of Directors may determine.

Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as the court may determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
