

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

OF

PAYETTE LAND AND IMPROVEMENT COMPANY LIMITED.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we the undersigned do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby set forth and declare as follows, to wit:

FIRST.

That the name of such corporation is and shall be when formed, Payette Land and Improvement Company Limited.

SECOND.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed, are; acquiring, buying, selling, leasing, mortgaging, improving, developing and disposing of town and farm lands with appurtenances, in Canyon County Idaho, in the Town of Payette or in the vicinity thereof; loaning money on real estate and other securities; engaging in agricultural operations; negotiating loans for State, municipal or private purposes; aiding in the promotion and organization of corporations having for their object the following or kindred purposes; agricultural or other industrial pursuits, supplying municipalities or farm lands with water, furnishing light or power to municipalities, corporations or persons, purchasing, developing, operating or working mining property or constructing railroads or canals.

THIRD.

The place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is the Town of Payette in the County of Canyon, State of Idaho.

FOURTH.

That the term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty years.

FIFTH.

That the number of the directors of said corporation shall be five.

SIXTH.

That the names and residences of those who are appointed directors for the first year are.
